APPLICATION FOR OUT OF STATE TUITION DIFFERENTIAL WAIVER
CAREER CONSULAR OFFICIALS – RENEWABLE/Spouse/Dependent

As of the first day of classes for the term, an waiver may be granted to a spouse or a dependent non-citizen student who can provide clear evidence that the student’s spouse, parent or U.S. court-appointed guardian is stationed and living in Georgia under the orders of their government.

The student may continue to receive this waiver as long as their spouse, parent/guardian maintains this assignment. This waiver will expire 12 months from the date the waiver was granted. An affected student must then provide current documentation that supports the continuation of the waiver.

- Copy of spouse’s, or parent/guardian’s current immigration documentation, including EAC(front& back)
- Letter or preprinted form from the Georgia consulate verifying that the career consular officer is a citizen of the foreign nation that their consular office represents and is stationed and living in Georgia under orders of their respective governments
- One of the following (depending on situation): a) birth certificate b) U.S. court documentation of guardianship c) marriage certificate

I understand that any material false statement made knowingly and willingly by me on this application, or any documents attached hereto may, in accordance with O.C.G.A. 16-10-71, which provides that upon conviction, a person who knowingly commits the offense of false swearing shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years, or both, subject me to prosecution in a court of law. Additionally, I further understand that any such false statement may subject me to immediate dismissal from the institution.

I understand that I must notify Kennesaw State University immediately if my spouse or parent/guardian is assigned employment outside the State of Georgia. I also understand this waiver, if approved, is valid for 12 months and I must reapply for the waiver at that time.
