ECONOMIC ADVANTAGE – RENEWABLE/Spouse

As of the first day of classes for the term, an economic advantage waiver may be granted to a non-citizen student who can provide clear evidence that the student’s spouse possesses a valid employment-related visa status and can provide clear evidence of having relocated to the State of Georgia to accept full-time, self-sustaining employment is also eligible to receive this waiver. Relocation to the state must be for employment reasons and not for the purpose of enrolling in an institution of higher education. These individuals must be able to show clear evidence of having taken legally permissible steps toward establishing legal permanent residence in the United States and the establishment of legal domicile in the State of Georgia. The student may continue to receive this waiver as long as their spouse maintains a valid employment-related visa status and can demonstrate continued efforts to establish U.S. legal permanent residence and legal domicile in the State of Georgia. This waiver will expire 12 months from the date the waiver was granted. An affected student must then provide current documentation that supports the continuation of the waiver.

I understand that any material false statement made knowingly and willingly by me on this application, or any documents attached hereto may, in accordance with O.C.G.A. 16-10-71, which provides that upon conviction, a person who knowingly commits the offense of false swearing shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years, or both, subject me to prosecution in a court of law. Additionally, I further understand that any such false statement may subject me to immediate dismissal from the institution.

I understand that I must notify Kennesaw State University immediately if my parent/guardian or spouse is assigned employment outside the State of Georgia. I also understand this waiver, if approved, is valid for 12 months and I must submit a Petition for Georgia Residency or renew my waiver once this waiver expires.
